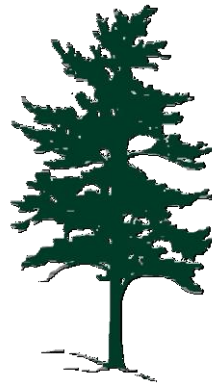


Facilities

What We Do



After-School Programs

KYC programs are open to all GWRSD middle and high school students. Programs run Monday through Thursday 2:40 to 4:40.

Programs are offered free of charge and include a hot meal upon arrival and indoor and outdoor activities. We also provide many local field trips and guest speakers, which are also free of charge.

We are able to offer these programs due to the generosity of our donors and volunteers.

Transportation

Students may get on the bus at school or have a parent or guardian drop them off at the KYC. Students return to school on the school bus in time to catch the late bus home.

Activities

We offer numerous activities everyday including arts and crafts, music, basketball, Wii, foosball, ping pong, cooking classes, homework assistance and guest presenters.



Field Trips

We offer one or two optional field trips per week. Trips this past year included Tumbledown Farm, ice skating at Pop Whalen, snow sledding, Wright Museum, Boat Museum, maple sugaring, Lakes Region Humane Society, giPlastek factory tour, Albee Beach, outdoor activities at local camps and more. We also took the members to the Wolfeboro Inn for cooking classes four weeks throughout the school year.

Students may join at any time during the school year. They will be given a permission form on their first visit and be required to return it signed on their second visit to the Center.
